

Victory On The Cross

Video- Palm Sunday

Colossians 2:13-15

13 You were dead because of your sins and because your sinful nature was not yet cut away. Then God made you alive with Christ, for he forgave all our sins.

14 He canceled the record of the charges against us and took it away by nailing it to the cross.

15 In this way, he disarmed the spiritual rulers and authorities. He shamed them publicly by his VICTORY OVER THEM ON THE CROSS.

Isaiah 53:4-5

4 Surely He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; the chastisement for our peace was upon Him, and by His stripes we are healed.

1 Cor. 12:28 (NKJV) - And God has appointed these in the church: first apostles, second prophets, third teachers, after that miracles, then gifts of HEALINGS, helps, administrations, varieties of tongues.

1. Jesus carried the weight of GRIEFS and SORROWS so that the JOY of SALVATION could be REVEALED!

Isaiah 53:4 - Surely, He has borne our griefs and carried our sorrows; yet we esteemed Him stricken, smitten by God, and afflicted.

Isaiah 12:3 - With joy you will draw water from the wells of salvation.

2. Jesus suffered from OPEN WOUNDS so that our OPEN SHAME could be REMOVED!

Isaiah 53:5a – “But He was wounded for our transgressions,”

3. Jesus experienced INTERNAL INJURY so that our INNER MAN could be RENEWED!

Isaiah 53:5b – “He was bruised for our iniquities;”

2 Corinthians 4:16 - "...yet our inner man is being renewed day by day.”

4. Jesus felt PUNISHMENT and REJECTION so that PEACE and RECONCILIATION could be REINSTATED!

Isaiah 53:5a – “the chastisement for our peace was upon Him”

5. Jesus received SAVAGE BLOWS to His Body so that healing for our SICKENED BODIES could be RECIEVED!

Isaiah 53:5d - "and by His stripes we are healed"

Psalms 34:17-20 (NIV)

17 The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.

18 The Lord is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.

19 A righteous man may have many troubles, but the Lord delivers him from them all;

20 he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.

Nehemiah 4:2 - He spoke before his relatives and the army of Samaria and said, “What are these feeble Jews doing? Are they fortifying themselves? Will they make sacrifices? Can they complete this in a day? Can they revive the BURNED-UP STONES out of the rubbish heaps?”

Job 19:25-26 (NIV)

25 I know that my Redeemer lives, and that in the end he will stand upon the earth.

26 And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God;

2 Cor 4:8-10 (KJV)

8 We are troubled on every side, yet not distressed; we are perplexed, but not in despair;

9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed;

10 Always bearing about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life also of Jesus might be made manifest in our body.
