

## It's Time For A Spiritual Transition!

Transition = The process or a period of changing from one state or condition to another.

1 Samuel 9:15-27

15. Now the day before Saul came, the LORD had revealed this to Samuel:

16. "About this time tomorrow I will send you a man from the land of Benjamin. Anoint him leader over my people Israel; he will deliver my people from the hand of the Philistines. I have looked upon my people, for their cry has reached me."

17. When Samuel caught sight of Saul, the LORD said to him, "This is the man I spoke to you about; he will govern my people."

18. Saul approached Samuel in the gateway and asked, "Would you please tell me where the seer's house is?"

19. "I am the seer," Samuel replied. "Go up ahead of me to the high place, for today you are to eat with me, and in the morning, I will let you go and will tell you all that is in your heart.

20. As for the donkeys you lost three days ago, do not worry about them; they have been found. And to whom is all the desire of Israel turned, if not to you and all your father's family?"

21. Saul answered, "But am I not a Benjamite, from the smallest tribe of Israel, and is not my clan the least of all the clans of the tribe of Benjamin? Why do you say such a thing to me?"

22. Then Samuel brought Saul and his servant into the hall and seated them at the head of those who were invited--about thirty in number.

23. Samuel said to the cook, "Bring the piece of meat I gave you, the one I told you to lay aside."

24. So the cook took up the leg with what was on it and set it in front of Saul. Samuel said, "Here is what has been kept for you. Eat, because it was set aside for you for this occasion, from the time I said, `I have invited guests.'" And Saul dined with Samuel that day.

25. After they came down from the high place to the town, Samuel talked with Saul on the roof of his house.

26. They rose about daybreak and Samuel called to Saul on the roof, "Get ready, and I will send you on your way." When Saul got ready, he and Samuel went outside together.

27. As they were going down to the edge of the town, Samuel said to Saul, "Tell the servant to go on ahead of us"--and the servant did so--"but you stay here awhile, so that I may give you a message from God."

1 Samuel 10:1 - Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured it on Saul's head and kissed him, saying, "Has not the LORD anointed you leader over his inheritance?"

1 Samuel 10:5-6

5. "After that you will go to Gibeah of God, where there is a Philistine outpost. As you approach the town, you will meet a procession of prophets coming down from the high place with lyres, tambourines, flutes and harps being played before them, and they will be prophesying.

6. The Spirit of the LORD will come upon you in power, and you will prophesy with them; and you will be changed into a different person.

1 Samuel 9:19 - "I am the seer," Samuel replied. "Go up ahead of me to the high place,

1 Samuel :21 - Saul answered, "But am I not a Benjamite, from the smallest tribe of Israel, and is not my clan the least of all the clans of the tribe of Benjamin? Why do you say such a thing to me?"

-Zech. 4:10 - "Who despises the day of small things?"

-Micah 5:2 - "But you, Bethlehem Ephrathah, though you are small among the clans of Judah, out of you will come for me one who will be ruler over Israel, whose origins are from of old, from ancient times. "

-Mt. 7:14 - But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.

-Mk. 3:9 - Because of the crowd he told his disciples to have a small boat ready for him, to keep the people from crowding him.

Mk. 12:42-43 - But a poor widow came and put in two very small copper coins, worth only a fraction of a penny. Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "I tell you the truth, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others.

1 Samuel 9:25 - After they came down from the high place to the town, Samuel talked with Saul on the roof of his house.

1 Samuel 9:27a - "Tell the servant to go on ahead of us":

Jn.1:12-13 - Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God--children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Rom.8:14-17 - because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship. And by him we cry, "Abba, Father." The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children. Now if we are children, then we are heirs--heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.

Gal.3:26 - You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus,

Gal. 4:4-7

4. But when the time had fully come, God sent his Son, born of a woman, born under law,

5. to redeem those under law, that we might receive the full rights of sons.

6. Because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, the Spirit who calls out, "Abba, Father."

7. So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, God has made you also an heir.

2 Cor. 6:17,18 - "Therefore come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."

1 Samuel 9:27b - and the servant did so (KJV And He Passed On):

vs9:27c - but you stay here awhile (KJV - But Stand thou Still Awhile):

Ps. 46:10 - Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth.

Back to 1 Samuel 9:26 - They rose about daybreak and Samuel called to Saul on the roof, "Get ready, and I will send you on your way." When Saul got ready, he and Samuel went outside together.

1 Samuel 9:27d - that I may give you a message from God." (KJV\_That I may show thee the word of God)

Hab. 2:1 - I will stand at my watch and station myself on the ramparts; I will look to see what he (God) will say to me,

Word/Message = (Heb. daw-baw) – a cause

Lit. - "that I may show you the cause of God."

Then after Saul has seen the Word, Samuel Anoints his head with Oil in 1 Samuel 10:1

1 Samuel 10:1 - Then Samuel took a flask of oil and poured it on Saul's head and kissed him, saying, "Has not the LORD anointed you leader over his inheritance?"

1 Samuel 10:5a - "that you will go to Gibeah of God, where there is a Philistine outpost.

1 Samuel 10:5b - As you approach the town, you will meet a procession of prophets coming down from the high place:

1 Samuel 10:5c - with lyres, tambourines, flutes and harps being played before them, and they will be prophesying.

1 Samuel 10:6a - The Spirit of the LORD will come upon you in power, and you will prophesy with them

1 Samuel 10:6b - and you will be changed (transitioned, overturned, turned into) into a different person:
