

Plug that Leak!

Hebrews 2:1-3 - We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away. For if the message spoken by angels was binding, and every violation and disobedience received its just punishment, how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him.

1. Sometimes we let our LOVE leak out!

Revelation 2:3-4— You have persevered and have endured hardships for my name, and have not grown weary. Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken your first love.

2. Sometimes we let our JOY leak out!

Psalms 51:12— Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

3. Sometimes we let our SENSITIVITY TO GOD leak out!

Hebrews 3:8— “do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion, during the time of testing in the desert,”

4. Sometimes we let our BURDEN FOR LOST PEOPLE leak out!

Matthew 9:36 - When he saw the crowds, he had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

6. Sometimes we let our PASSIONATE FIRE FOR GOD leak out!

Matthew 15:8— 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.

Revelation 3:15-16- 15

15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I wish you were either one or the other!

16 So, because you are lukewarm—neither hot nor cold—I am about to spit you out of my mouth.

7. Sometimes we let our KINGDOM PRIORITIES leak out!

Matthew 6:33— But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Phil. 3: 14 - I press on toward the goal to win the prize for which God has called me heavenward in Christ Jesus.

And Colossians 3:1-3 - Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God. Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things. For you died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God.
