

When Christ Was Crucified!

Gal. 2:20 - I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

1 Cor. 1:17-18

17. For Christ did not send me to baptize, but to preach the gospel--not with words of human wisdom, lest the cross of Christ be emptied of its power.

18. For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God.

Gal. 6:14 - May I never boast except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Phil. 3:18 - For, as I have often told you before and now say again even with tears, many live as enemies of the cross of Christ.

I. When Christ Was Crucified, SIN was Crucified!

2 Corinthians 5:21—God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Rom. 6:6-7

6. For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--

7. because anyone who has died has been freed from sin.

Rom. 6:14 - For sin shall not be your master, because you are not under law, but under grace.

II. When Christ Was Crucified, THE CURSE was Crucified!

Galatians 3:13-14--because it is written, cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree.

III. When Christ Was Crucified, UNGODLY FEAR was Crucified!

Hebrews 2:14-15

14. Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might destroy him who holds the power of death--that is, the devil--

15. and free those who all their lives were held in slavery by their fear of death.

IV. When Christ Was Crucified, DEATH was Crucified!

Col. 2:14 says that the "written code" was canceled by being nailed to the cross.

Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.

Romans 6:4-9

4. We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.

5. If we have been united with him like this in his death, we will certainly also be united with him in his resurrection.

6. For we know that our old self was crucified with him so that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin--

7. because anyone who has died has been freed from sin.

8. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we will also live with him.

9. For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, he cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over him.

Colossians 2:9-12

9. For in Christ all the fullness of the Deity lives in bodily form,

10. and you have been given fullness in Christ, who is the head over every power and authority.

11. In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ,

12. having been buried with him in baptism and raised with him through your faith in the power of God, who raised him from the dead.

2 Timothy 1:10 - but it has now been revealed through the appearing of our Savior, Christ Jesus, who has destroyed death and has brought life and immortality to light through the gospel.

Rev. 1:18 - I am the Living One; I was dead, and behold I am alive forever and ever! And I hold the keys of death and Hades.

V. When Christ Was Crucified, SEPARATION FROM GOD (veil) was Crucified!

Ephesians 2:13-18

13. But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.

14. For he himself is our peace, who has made the two one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility,

15. by abolishing in his flesh the law with its commandments and regulations. His purpose was to create in himself one new man out of the two, thus making peace,

16. and in this one body to reconcile both of them to God through the cross, by which he put to death their hostility.

17. He came and preached peace to you who were far away and peace to those who were near.

18. For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

Matthew 27:51- At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook and the rocks split.

Hebrews 10:19-20 - Therefore, brothers, since we have confidence to enter the Most Holy Place by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way opened for us through the curtain, that is, his body,

Hebrews 9:12 - He did not enter by means of the blood of goats and calves; but he entered the Most Holy Place once for all by his own blood, having obtained eternal redemption.

Hebrews 9:24 - For Christ did not enter a man-made sanctuary that was only a copy of the true one; he entered heaven itself, now to appear for us in God's presence.

Hebrews 7:23-24 - Now there have been many of those priests, since death prevented them from continuing in office; but because Jesus lives forever, he has a permanent priesthood.

Romans 5:1-2 - Therefore, since we have been justified through faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we rejoice in the hope of the glory of God.

Ephesians 2:18 - For through him we both have access to the Father by one Spirit.

Ephesians 3:12 - In him and through faith in him we may approach God with freedom and confidence.

Hebrews 4:16 - Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

VI. When Christ Was Crucified, OUR FAILURES were Crucified!

2 Cor. 5:21 - God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

I Corinthians 15:57 - But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 2:14 - But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumphal procession in Christ and through us spreads everywhere the fragrance of the knowledge of him.

John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full. (KJV-more abundantly)

VII. When Christ Was Crucified, SATAN'S DOMINION was Crucified!

I Corinthians 2:8 - None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

Colossians 2:15 - having canceled the written code, with its regulations, that was against us and that stood opposed to us; he took it away, nailing it to the cross.

Genesis—3:15- And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and

between your offspring and hers; he will crush your head, and you will strike his heel."

Romans 16:20, The God of peace will soon crush Satan under your feet. The grace of our Lord Jesus be with you.

1Cor. 1:21-24

21. For since in the wisdom of God the world through its wisdom did not know him, God was pleased through the foolishness of what was preached to save those who believe.

22. Jews demand miraculous signs and Greeks look for wisdom,

23. but we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles,

24. but to those whom God has called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.
