

You Can't Keep A Captive's Motives When You Have A Deliverer's Destiny!

We are either a captive or a deliverer!

1 Corinthians 4:2-5

2. Now it is required that those who have been given a trust must prove faithful.
3. I care very little if I am judged by you or by any human court; indeed, I do not even judge myself.
4. My conscience is clear, but that does not make me innocent. It is the Lord who judges me.
5. Therefore judge nothing before the appointed time; wait till the Lord comes. He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of men's hearts. At that time each will receive his praise from God.

Proverbs 16:1-2

1. To man belong the plans of the heart, but from the LORD comes the reply of the tongue.
2. All a man's ways seem innocent to him, but motives are weighed by the LORD.

We've got to be willing to examine and correct the motives for serving God!

You can't keep a captive's motives when you have a deliverer's destiny!

Motive = "That within the individual, rather than without, which incites him to action; any idea, need, emotion, or organic state that prompts to an action."

1. Some people serve out of selfish ambition!

A. W. TOZER - "Many a solo is sung to show off; many a sermon is preached as an exhibition of talent; many a church is founded as a slap to some other church. Even missionary activity may become competitive, and soul-winning may degenerate into a sort of brush-salesman project to satisfy the flesh."

2. Some people serve out of greed!

1 Timothy 6:3-10

3. If anyone teaches false doctrines and does not agree to the sound instruction of our Lord Jesus Christ and to godly teaching,
4. he is conceited and understands nothing. He has an unhealthy interest in controversies and quarrels about words that result in envy, strife, malicious talk, evil suspicions
5. and constant friction between men of corrupt mind, who have been robbed of the truth and who think that godliness is a means to financial gain.
6. But godliness with contentment is great gain.
7. For we brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.
8. But if we have food and clothing, we will be content with that.
9. People who want to get rich fall into temptation and a trap and into many foolish and harmful desires that plunge men into ruin and destruction.
10. For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

Money should never be the motive for serving God!

1 Thessalonians 2:3-5

3. For the appeal we make does not spring from error or impure motives, nor are we trying to trick you.
4. On the contrary, we speak as men approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please men but God, who tests our hearts.
5. You know we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed--God is our witness.

3. Some people serve without really loving others!

1Cor. 13:3 - "If I give all I possess to the poor and surrender my body to the flames, but have not love, I gain nothing."

A. W. TOZER - "It is not what a man does that determines whether his work is sacred or secular, it is why he does it."

Proverbs 16:2 - All a man's ways seem innocent to him, but motives are weighed by the LORD.

Hebrews 4:12-13 - For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all

creation is hidden from God's sight EVERYTHING is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

James 4:3 - "When you ask, you do not receive, because you ask with wrong motives, that you may spend what you get on your pleasures!"

These folks serve God for only what they can get out of Him!

Some people try to climb the ladder of church success like a lot like folks climb the corporate ladder!

No title in the Church or certificate of accomplishment or talent or even spiritual gifting will mean a hill of beans in the end!

1 Corinthians 4:5 says,... "He will bring to light what is hidden in darkness and will expose the motives of men's hearts. At that time each will receive his praise from God."
